

HOMMAGE A EMMA GAD

Emma Gad, born 1852, was a danish writer, who defined proper behaviour in *The Manners of Good Society* (1918).

In compliment to her 165 danes were invited to dine in the courtyard of the Royal Palace, Amalienborg, the 29th of August 1982 from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m.

The participants were selected in such a way that anybody would be well acquainted with at least five other invitees, but not with more than ten.

Apart from 26 persons, the invitees were permitted to be accompanied by each one person of own choice.

Each participant could veto up to 2 other participants and 2 companions.

All participants and companions had the choice of 34 dishes, 40 drinkables, 25 entertainments, 13 means of transport and 15 newspapers.

The courtyard was fitted with every convenience such as boarded floor, windscreen, control of temperature, stages, tables, chairs and table accessories.

63 of the 165 invitees gave notice of participation and put at the same time a veto on 86 persons.

By extreme improbable chance veto was put on all 63 participants.

As a consequence the number of participants equated minus 23 persons.

The probability of this coincidence has been calculated by Niels Bak from the danish company Regnecentralen A/S.

The figure is 3×10^{-36} , -
approximately half the probability of a nuclear plant core melt.

HOMMAGE A EMMA GAD

- I. Apply to the Copenhagen Police for permission to express your confidence in monarchy and the House of Glücksburg the 29th of August 1982 from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. in the courtyard of the Royal Palace, Amalienborg.
Stating that a nation-wide campaign in favour of monarchy will be initiated on that occasion.
Describe in detail that the courtyard will be fitted with boarded floor, windscreen, control of temperature, stages, tables and chairs.
Mentioning that the date had been chosen to commemorate the anniversary of the 29th of August 1944.
(The majority of the danish police force was arrested by the german army of occupation).

Petition was granted the 23rd of August 1982.

- II. Select 165 participants. Leave it to the invitees to determine the final number of participants, - from 304 to minus 82.

The number was decided the 21st of August 1982: minus 23 persons.

- III. Announce a demonstration at the Royal Palace the 29th of August 1982 from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. in favour of double-monarchy.
Give a number of adequate reasons in support of this form of government.
Mentioning prior experiments, e.g. Eric Andersen's proposition of 1972 for the town Göttingen and the open letter of the 25th of January 1980 from the danish to the german people.

Press release was published the 25th of August 1982.
